## 2012 LANDFILL RATE INCREASE

The wildfires and flooding of 2011, combined with reconstruction and recovery efforts, have placed an unprecedented demand on your regional landfill. We have met this demand by creating additional landfill capacity, by purchasing equipment that enables us to manage the region's solid waste and recycling needs as efficiently as possible, and by planning for future expansion.

These changes are essential, and the cost of these changes must be reflected in an overall increase in landfill rates for 2012. A copy of the new landfill rates, along with a more thorough report of the landfill expansion initiatives, will be mailed to residents and business owners.
